COVID-19 concerns to cancel 2021 St. Paul Island Tour season

As we all know, over the past “COVID-19 Year” much has changed for all of us in Alaska, the United States and the World. Thankfully we have come a long way to mitigate the virus since March of last year when COVID-19 began its rapid march around the world. This past year, the community of St. Paul has made many great sacrifices to keep the island safe from COVID-19, and to-date has not had a single positive COVID-19 confirmed case!

We have worked closely with the St. Paul City Council and Unified Command monitor progress with COVID-19 protocols, vaccinations, and conditions that would allow us to safely conduct our tour. As part of this process, we completed a survey of the community of St. Paul, and a solid majority have expressed concern for the health and well-being of everyone on island, particularly the children of St. Paul that do not have vaccinations. We hear these concerns and agree that this year is not the right time to resume tourism to St. Paul Island, and as such, our tour season for 2021 is cancelled.

Any guest or group whose tour is affected and has been cancelled will be offered the following options regarding your cancelled tour:

- 1) Hold your existing deposits to confirm blocks and space for the 2022 season (now open for booking).
- 2) If we have collected any deposit for a held reservation, we will refund your deposit and funds paid for your 2021 tour – no questions asked.
